## 2011 Regional Decorative Painting Convention

### TEACHER CONTRACT

I hereby make application to teach at the 2011 Paint A Season Of Memories Regional Decorative Painting Convention in Portland, Oregon. In keeping with this contract, I will abide by the following rules and regulations.

1. All teachers must be members in good standing of the Society of Decorative Painters.

Teachers must not use the class period for selling or promoting anything that is not required for the class, nor is it permissible to promote seminars, books, pattern packets or products. The teacher may not permit any other person to sell, promote or announce seminars, books, or products during the class period.

Projects submitted must be for four (4) or six (6) hour classes. Projects should be completed by a majority of the students within the class period.

The teacher agrees to accept up to 25 students per class.

It is the responsibility of the teacher to provide each student with a prepared painting surface with pattern traced on, paint medium, complete pattern, written instructions and one color photograph of the project being taught. All of these items must be included in the cost of the project to the student. All parts shown in the project photograph must be included and provided at the specified cost indicated on the project information sheet. The painting surface provided to the student must be the same as shown in the photograph submitted. Should the student not complete the project in class, the teacher must provide the student with sufficient paint to complete the project.

The project cost listed on the Project Data Sheet will be published in our brochure and must be adhered to.

The teacher must supply a display sample of the class project to the class sales by 6:00 pm on Thursday, September 22, 2011. If the teacher cannot deliver the sample by that time, the sample must be shipped to arrive two weeks prior to the convention.

The class sample will be on display in the class sales area at all times during the convention, except when the class is in progress. Class samples will be available for pick up on the final day of classes.

A teacher will receive \$12.00 /student in a four (4) hour class and \$15.00 /student in a six (6) hour class. The teacher will be paid for "no shows", and will receive payment for the class taught approximately two weeks following the close of the convention.

Teachers are not required to register unless taking classes.

The teacher must follow the "NO SMOKING" policy in the classrooms and other designated areas.

Cancellation Policy: A teacher may not cancel the obligation to teach once the project has been published in the class registration catalog. Cancellations may only be considered in the event of personal or family emergencies. Otherwise, the teacher cannot be considered for teaching in subsequent Convention years.

# Project piece may not have been taught at any other seminar or convention within the Western United States prior to convention date.

Raindrop Chapter requests a copy of the pattern packet for its notebook, to be turned in with the class sample.

With regard to copyright, I will check the statement below that is applicable to the project(s) submitted:

I warrant and represent that the project submitted is original with myself in all respects; that no part thereof infringes the copyright of any other person or organization, that I have not copied or used the designs of any copyrighted work and have not infringed on the copyright or any right of any person or organization.

Furthermore, I agree that in the case if any suit for copyright infringement arising out of the work herein submitted, I will assume responsibility and costs for the defense of said suit and hold the Raindrop Chapter of the SDP innocent of any act of infringement.

I hereby agree to teach the projects accepted by the Raindrop Chapter, and to abide by the rules and regulations above and all information included in the Teacher Project Packet. I grant permission to publish all project(s) accepted in the convention brochure.
